Have you ever wanted to code robots? Dig and examine soil samples from 12 feet underground? Dissect owl pellets or fish? Look deep inside a tree? Test water? Now is your chance!

This summer Swan Valley Elementary School will be having STEM Summer Camp. This is a three-week day camp. We will be exploring local science and robotics with Ozobots, daily.

There will be two sessions for this camp: A morning session for incoming k-4 students and an afternoon session for students going into 5th-9th grade.

The first two weeks we will explore place-based STEM topics, coding, and robotics. The last week will focus on inquiry-based projects that will incorporate design-thinking and relating topics from the first two weeks to real world problem.

On August 23rd, all students are expected to attend from 8:30 am-11:30 am. At 11:30 we will present our completed projects and have lunch. All families and friends are invited to attend.
