- 1. Call to Order
 - Chairman Hicks called the meeting to order at 6:05 and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2. Roll Call

- 3. - 4. Agenda Adoption
 - Chairman Hicks called for a motion to adopt the proposed agenda. Mr. Steffes so moved. Mr. Lundquist seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
- 5. After board review, the minutes of the 10/9/13 board meeting minutes were ordered to stand as read.
