  - a. Chairman Liss, Vice-Chairman McClure, Superintendent Jacobson and Clerk Heilesen all present. Trustee Brainard not present.

- IV. **SWAN VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT #92 BUDGET HEARING - Starts at 7:00 PM: The board discussed the budget for FY23.**
- V. **INFORMATION ITEMS/REPORTS**
  - a. Superintendent Report
    - i. 5K Fun Run was on May 21<sup>st</sup>. The PTO had a large number of sponsorships and support. The weather was great, and the participants had a great time.
    - ii. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation was on May 26<sup>th</sup>. We had 9 students graduate this year. Thank you, Shane Liss, for your speech at the graduation. The staff really appreciated it.
    - iii. Missoula Children's Theatre was the week of May 9<sup>th</sup> -13<sup>th</sup>. The play was Alice in Wonderland. K - 8<sup>th</sup> grade were all able to participate. We received a donation from the American Legion Hall to pay for MCT for 2023. Thank you to the American Legion Hall.
    - iv. Northwest Farm Credit Services of America - \$2,500 Grant for Playground: We received this grant thank you to the help of Andy Lundquist. This grant will help get Phase III of the playground going.
    - v. Expanding Art Access in Rural Public Schools Grant - \$15,000 for Music & Art
    - vi. Staff Retention Update: We have 100% staff retention for next school year. We have received all of our letters of intent and signed contracts for FY23. This is great news for us!
    - vii. Swan Valley School Library Update: The School has always been contracted with Idaho Falls Public library. As of this spring, Idaho Falls Public Library has decided to only service Idaho Falls and not surrounding areas. We will now be contracting with Bonneville County Library. This change will take place in August/September.
    - viii. Cement Work Sidewalk and Back Door: We were able to get our cement fixed. We were able to get this marked off our to-do list with our Plant Levy money.
    - ix. Carpet Cleaning: We got the carpets cleaned on June 7<sup>th</sup>. This is an annual thing we do as soon as school is out for the summer.
    - x. ISAT 2021-22 Testing Preliminary Results: ELA 77%, Math 60%, and Science (Not Available) of students proficient or advanced
      1. ISAT 2020-21 Results: ELA 76%, Math 57%, and Science (Not Available) of students proficient or advanced
    - xi. Spring 2022 IRI - 64.3% of students in K-3 scored in Tier 1
      1. Fall 2021 51.7 % of students in K-3 scored in Tier 1
      2. Spring 2021 IRI - 64.3% of students in K-3 scored in Tier 1
    - xii. Quarter 4 K-8 Attendance 93.9%, 16 K-8 and 5 PK Students 100%/ YTD 92.1%
      1. 2020-2021 Q4 K-8 Attendance 92.7%, 13 K-8 100%/ YTD 93.3%
  - b. HVAC Update: We are waiting to get things finalized from the engineer so we can put the HVAC project out for bid.
    - i. New Controls/Valves: All of the controls have been updated and taken care of.
    - ii. Engineering Systems Solutions
    - iii. Lower Valley Energy: We have the transformer for Phase III power on the way.
  - c. Swan Valley School District #92 - Plant Levy: Small discussion was held.
