To The Community of Swan Valley,

On behalf of the board of trustees for Swan Valley School District #92 and Superintendent Michael Jacobson, we want to take a minute to thank our community for the support of our \$75,000 per year plant levy for the next five years. We received approximately 68% votes in favor of the levy, well beyond the 55% minimum required.

We have worked really hard over the past several years to address many pressing needs at the school such as upgrading our playground, upgrading our drinking fountains, purchasing a new high school shuttle car, repairing and sealing the school parking lot, updating our surveillance system, purchasing a new bus, removing deteriorating trees, replacing a failed fuel pump, and upgrading classroom furniture. Many of these issues we have been fortunate to receive grants or donations to address these issues which has allowed past plant levy funds to be stretched even further.

For 2023 we hope to move forward with 3 phase power upgrades in preparation for a new HVAC system in 2024, a new fire alarm system, work with Idaho Department of Transportation to improve highway safety in our school zone, reseal gym floor and install new volleyball system, repair sprinkler system around the playground, septic tank pumping, and take steps to address masonry repairs. Some of these projects will be covered by donations and grants, thus continuing to stretch your plant levy dollars.

We hold ourselves to a high standard of fiscal responsibility and prudent care of our facilities. As we strive to take care of our building, we hope it will not only serve the current students of our community but many more generations to come.
